<b>Tobacco Prevention Quarter Update</b>	<p>Point of Sale Task Force: AVC inspections are currently taking place in Martin County. The stores with an AVC agreement are mostly all in compliance with very few violations found, but this data will be helpful when reporting to non-AVC retail stores facing a greater number of violations.</p> <p>Smokeless Tobacco: ArtsFest has gone tobacco free this year and signage will be up at the arts festival this weekend. The Martin County Fair is also entering its third tobacco free year and 45 SWAT Club members will be working a booth for Through With Chew Week over the weekend.</p> <p>SFMUH: Laura will help provide contact information for the new apartment complexes being built in Downtown Stuart so that Kim can contact them for a tobacco free policy before they begin leasing.</p> <p>Tobacco Free Worksites: Suggestions were made to contact Helping People Succeed and other large non-profit employers to discuss tobacco free policies.
