| Items for Approval | <p><u>Overview of May Meeting Minutes:</u> Motion to approve meeting minutes made by Barry, seconded by Jennifer; All in favor.</p> <p><u>Budget Report:</u></p> <p>\$4725 was budgeted for the year, which will be divided between memberships (\$725), event registrations (\$1000), and sponsorships (\$3000).</p> | Approved Unanimously |
| Tobacco Prevention Quarter Update | <p>Point of Sale Task Force: Kim and Jennifer A. are working with the county on a possible ENDS policy, restricting ENDS use wherever smoking is banned in the FL Clean Indoor Air Act. A meeting will be scheduled with new county staff to continue these efforts.</p> <p>Smokeless Tobacco: A sample tobacco free events policy and a corresponding tool kit were developed for the City of Stuart. This document will be handed out with event permits to make it easy for event organizers to adopt a tobacco free policy. The toolkit includes information on free signage and advertisement of the tobacco free policy.</p> <p>The county has removed some of the tobacco free signs at local sports fields. Efforts will continue to increase the amount of signage at these parks to promote tobacco free ballparks in the county. Additionally, step-in signs will be ordered to be distributed through local sports leagues.</p> <p>SFMUH: Efforts continue with local apartment complexes, retirement homes and other multi-unit housing properties for the adoption of tobacco free policies. Sandhill Cove Retirement Living commented on the positive results they've seen since going tobacco free.</p> <p>Tobacco Free Worksites: Orange Theory Fitness recently adopted a tobacco free workplace policy. Additionally, The Law Offices of Willie Gary are contemplating a tobacco free workplace policy.</p> <p>Students Working Against Tobacco (SWAT) Updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • JBHS SWAT Group is working on an activity schedule for this school year.
