Tobacco Prevention Quarter Update	<p>Point of Sale Task Force: The task force met with a commissioner who is championing Tobacco 21 for Martin County. The commission voted to move forward with drafting an ordinance. The partnership will print pledge cards in support and help the commissioners’ efforts.</p> <p>Dawn is working on the Martin Youth LEADERShip Health and Wellness day and will be incorporating vaping and substance abuse.</p> <p>Tobacco Free Environments: The Indiantown Rodeo is working on a tobacco free policy and displayed tobacco free event signage this year. Other events to consider include: Pineapple Fest, Stuart Green Market, Jammin’ Jensen, and the Christmas parades.</p> <p>SFMUH: Azul Apartments opened with a tobacco free policy and signage is currently being designed. Portofino in Jensen Beach was suggested as a property to meet with for smoke free policies. Sandhill Cove provided an update about the positive response to their tobacco free policy.</p> <p>Tobacco Free Worksites: O’Donnell Windows is considering a policy.
