Participation in the fair followed school district and health department guidance.</p>	Approved Unanimously
Tobacco Prevention Quarter Update	<p>Point of Sale Task Force: The City of Stuart passed an ordinance raising the age of sale to 21 and implementing code enforcement checks on stores with a fee schedule. Follow up will take place after enforcement data is gathered to discuss possible retail license requirements.</p> <p>Surveys are also taking place currently of 50 retailers in Martin County to determine placement, pricing, and marketing of tobacco products.</p> <p>Tobacco Free Environments: The Martin County Fair and Artsfest both took place with tobacco free signage this quarter. Future events, including the rodeo, will be contact for additional policy assistance.</p> <p>SFMUH: A collaborative call with Indian River, St. Lucie and Palm Beach counties took place to discuss successes and challenges. Many are working with condo projects with some success.</p> <p>TFW: American Heart Association is collaborating with us to review the school district policy. An update will be provided next meeting.</p> <p>Students Working Against Tobacco (SWAT) Updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SWAT Clubs have been meeting both virtually and in person as schools allow, practicing social distancing. • The YMCA is having small group meetings but working on branching out to new students as enrollment grows in light of COVID-19. <p>Updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dr. Hummel shared the SB and HB updates hat would remove preemption and allow local municipalities to discuss tobacco free parks and beaches policies.
